Sweetwater Rooftop Bar

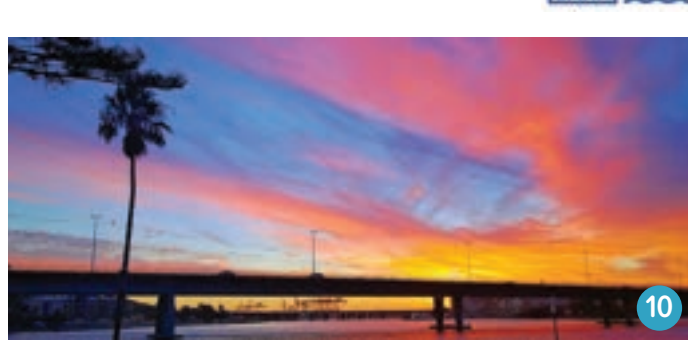

Built by convicts in the 1850s and decommissioned as an operating maximum security gaol in 1991, visitors can now 'step inside and do time' on a range of fascinating tours. Join a Prison Day Tour to hear about the daily life of convicts and prisoners, descend 20 metres into the depths below on an underground Tunnels Tour, or join an eerie Torchlight Tour as guides delve into the darker side of the Prison's history, at night.

Enjoy a drink in the original courtroom, jury room and dock, learn about the infamous characters that passed through the court and enjoy some West Aussie produce in the stunning glass pavilion overlooking the garden, shaded by mature peppermint trees with a sandpit for the kids. With a nod to the building's original construction date, the extensive bar menu offers 99 wines, 18 gins and 18 whiskies!
