Transwa is WA's regional public transport provider, connecting more than 240 places from Kalbarri in the north to Esperance in the south. Transwa has a five-star road coach fleet which includes on-board entertainment and USB ports. Transwa also operates three rail services, including the modern Prospector train to Kalgoorlie, the scenic Australind train to Bunbury and the commuter AvonLink/MerredinLink service to Northam and Merredin. All of Transwa's services are accessible and have bathroom facilities. A 50% concession discount is offered to a wide range of card holders, including Seniors, WA Pensioners and children under 16 years

ROAD SAFETY COMMISSION



80% of fatigue related crashes are on country roads. To arm yourself against it, get at least 7.5 hours sleep before driving. On long journeys, take a break every 2 hours and swap drivers regularly. Finally, beware of roaming wildlife, with most activity occurring around sunrise and sunset. If you do see an animal on the road sound your horn, and if it is safe to do so, drive slowly around them. Do not swerve around an animal to avoid.

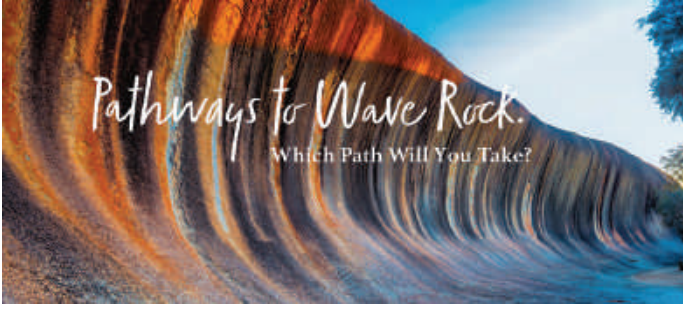
