



# **GETTING THERE**

Although covering a vast area, the Perth Hills Region is mostly within a half to one hour drive from the Perth CBD. Travelling by car is the easiest way to see and experience this beautiful countryside however let us share some alternative options! You can also visit transperth.wa.gov.au/journey-planner and simply enter your destination and it will suggest bus routes into the Perth Hills; the website also features language interpretation. The Midland and Armadale Train Line can only take you so far, but then you'll need to make alternative transport arrangements.
