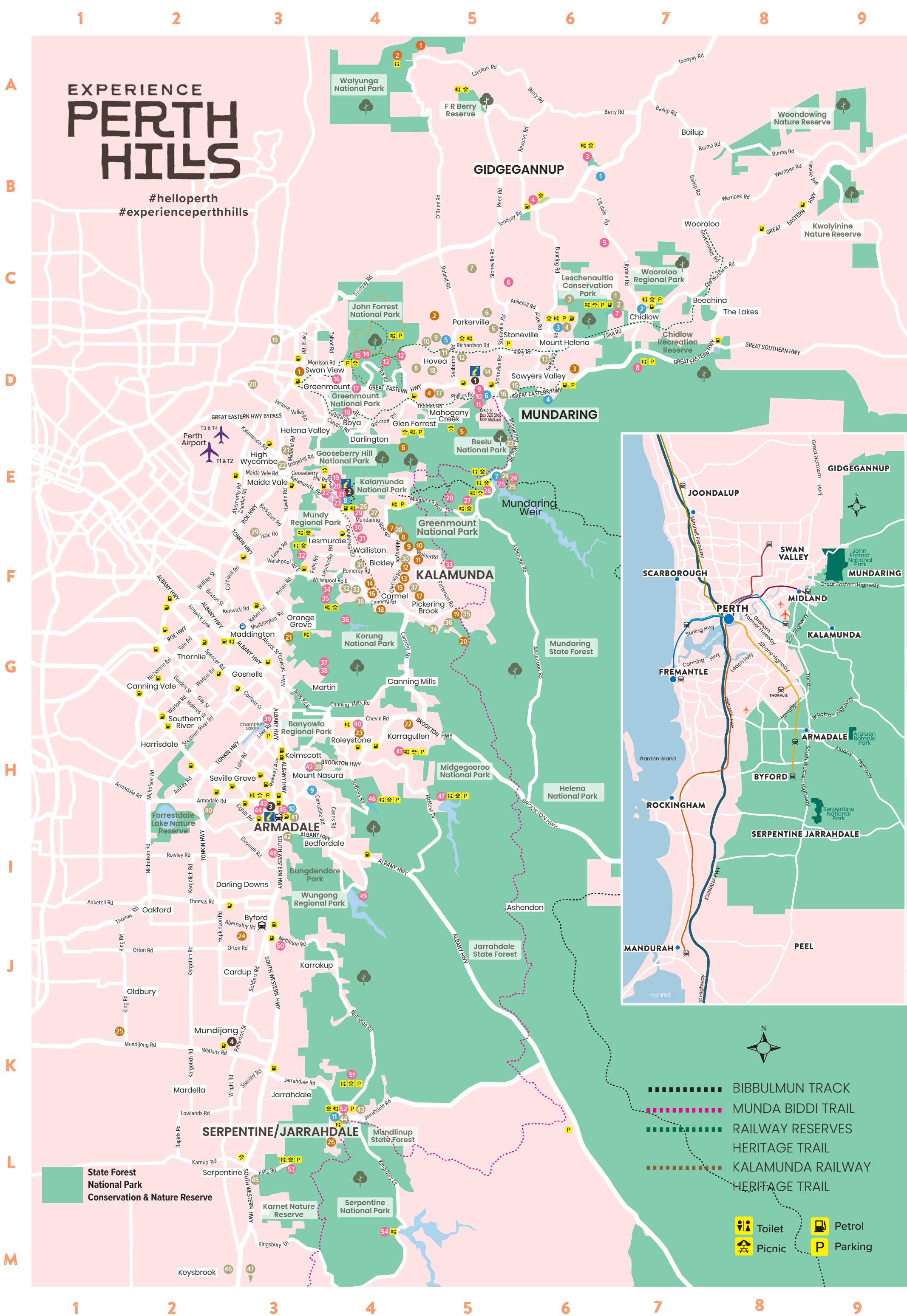
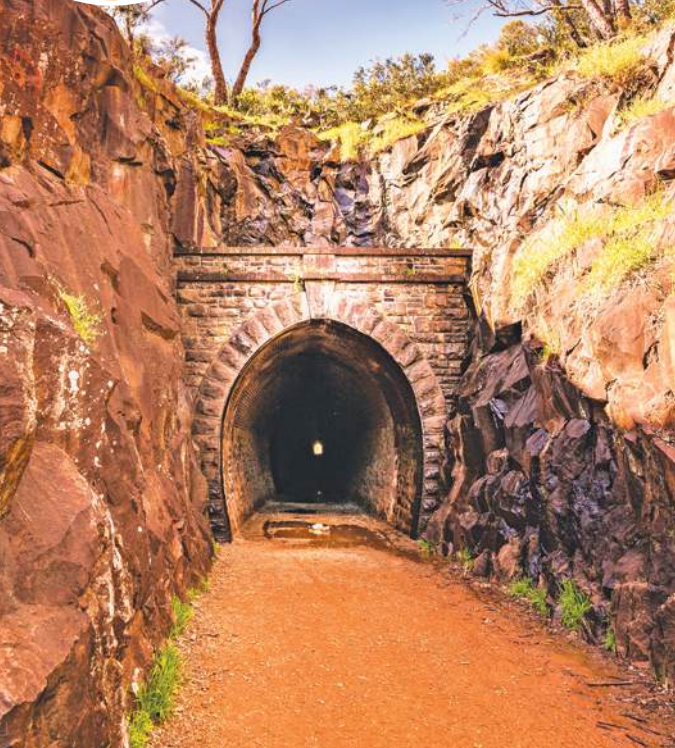

GETTING THERE

Although covering a vast area, the Perth Hills Region is mostly within a half to one hour drive from the Perth CBD. Travelling by car is the easiest way to see and experience this beautiful countryside however let us share some alternative options! Why not take a day tour and take the driving hassle out of your day? ... especially if your trip involves sampling some locally made wine!

You can also visit transperth.wa.gov.au/journey-planner and simply enter your destination and it will suggest bus routes into the Perth Hills; the website also features language interpretation. The Midland and Armadale Train Line can only take you so far, but then you'll need to make alternative transport arrangements. Depending on your destination contact the Visitor Centres listed on this map and the helpful staff will be able to assist you with any enquiries regarding your visit, including transport, accommodation and itineraries.

The Kalamunda History Village is the largest folk museum in WA. It sits on the site of the old Upper Darling Range Railway Station; the station buildings and platform are on the National Trust List of Heritage Places. Local heritage buildings were relocated to the Village and decorated to show life in pioneer times, including a schoolhouse and blacksmith's shop.
