










The Marmion Marine Park was WA's first marine park, declared in 1987 and named after early settler Patrick Marmion (1815-1856) who operated a whaling station in the area in 1849. North of Trigg, the park covers an area of 10,500 ha, from Trigg Island to Burns Beach, and is an ocean lover's paradise. Clear shallow lagoons, reefs, and small islands provide habitats for a diverse range of seabirds and marine mammals, in particular the bottlenose dolphin and, at certain times of the year, humpback whales.
