GETTING THERE



There are three ferry operators that run ferry services to the island from four locations: Perth, Fremantle (B Shed), Northport (10 minutes from Fremantle) and Hillarys Boat Harbour; please see the Ferry Route Map overlaid. Rottnest Express run services from Perth, Fremantle and Northport. Sealink run services from Fremantle (B Shed) and they also connect with Captain Cook Cruises Swan River transfers between Perth and Fremantle. Rottnest Fast Ferries services depart from Hillarys Boat Harbour. Rottnest ferries take approximately 25 minutes from Fremantle, 45 minutes from Hillarys Boat Harbour, or 90 minutes from Perth's Barrack Street Jetty and prices can vary from \$50 to \$70AU for return fares.


