GETTING THERE



There are three ferry operators that run ferry services to the island from four locations: Perth, Fremantle (B Shed), Northport (10 minutes from Fremantle) and Hillarys Boat Harbour; please see the Ferry Route Map overleaf. Rottnest Express run services from Perth, Fremantle and Northport. Sealink run services from Fremantle (B Shed) and they also connect with Captain Cook Cruises Swan River transfers between Perth and Fremantle. Rottnest Fast Ferries services depart from Hillarys Boat Harbour. Rottnest ferries take approximately 25 minutes from Fremantle, 45 minutes from Hillarys Boat Harbour, or 90 minutes from Perth's Barrack Street Jetty and prices can vary from \$50 to \$70AU for return fares. 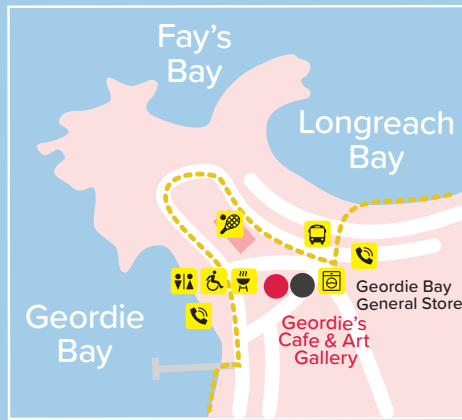

- The island is a culturally significant site for Aboriginal people so treat Aboriginal and heritage sites with respect
- Help protect the wildlife by not feeding or touching
- Leave only footprints, take your rubbish with you and help keep the island beautiful
- Take care when swimming, avoid cliff edges, watch for currents, waves, boats and wildlife; please obey all warning signs
- Protect the flora by staying on cycle and walk paths
- Lighting fires is prohibited
- On the spot fines of \$150 may apply to anyone seen interfering with animals (including feeding)
- Stay hydrated and take water with you; there is limited water outside the settlement
