

The first people to have inhabited the Mandurah region were the Bindjareb people of the Noongar Nation, who named the locality Mandjoogoordap, which translates as 'meeting place of the heart'. In 1828, Englishman Thomas Peel established a small settlement at the mouth of the Peel-Harvey Estuary, that was to become Mandurah. In the late 1800s, the quiet fishing village carved an existence from fishing, farming and canneries. In 1846, Western Australia's first mining operation was established at Yarrabah (near present-day Mundijong), mining lead, silver and zinc. The Jarrahdale timber mill, established in May 1872, became the state's largest timber operation, and led to the development of service centres for the timber industry along the Perth–Picton railway line at Mundijong, Waroona and Dwellingup. In recent times, the timber industry has declined, but the establishment of alumina refineries at Pinjarra and Wagerup, and gold mines at Boddington, have helped the local economy.
