

Getting Around

Getting around Perth and beyond is safe and easy with an efficient rail, bus and coach service, wide roads and clear signage, free CAT Buses, ferries, open top double decker buses, taxis or you can even fly! To mak eit even easier, ther eare plentu of tour companies to show you around with affordable day or extended tours.

Transperth provides public transport services within the Perth metropolitan area, with an integrated bus and train network (see the map, right). They also provide regular ferry services across the Swan River from Elizabeth Quay to Mends Street Jetty in South Perth. All routes, timetables and a journey planner are available online at transperth.wa.gov.au or you can download the free official Transperth app.

Perth City has a Free Transit Zone served by hop-on-hopoff Red, Green, Blue and Yellow CAT buses. Routes and stops are marked on the Perth City map. Free CAT buses also operate in Fremantle and Joondalup. Ticket machines accept cash or cards or, if you are staying for an extended period, you may purchase a SmartRider for discount fares. See the Transperth website for details of fares and concessions available. You need to travel with a valid ticket outside the free transit zone.

Four private ferry companies operate from Barrack Street Jetty. Captain Cook Cruises operates pleasure cruises along the Swan River, from Perth to Fremantle and the Swan Valley. Rottnest Express and Sealink operate services to Rottnest Island from Perth and Fremantle. The Little Ferry Company has regular services between Elizabeth Quay and Claisebook (East Perth). Rottnest Fast Ferries operates between Hillarys Boat Harbour and Rottnest Island.

Rideshare and taxi services are available, and a taxi service for passengers with disabilities may be booked 24 hours in advance on 9333 3377. Hire car services operate from Perth Airport and many other locations.
