

HELLO & WELCOME!

The Avon Valley was Western Australia's first inland settled region, rich in green rolling hills, babbling brooks, fertile lands and historic country towns. Experience an authentic Western Australian country experience, whether for a day trip or extended stay. Visit the vintage towns of Toodyay, Goomalling, Northam, York and Beverley as all of the towns are only a 30 minute drive from each other, providing a perfect Avon Valley loop road trip throughout the region.

An hour's drive east of Perth, the Avon Valley is home to Ballardong, Whadjuk and Yued people, who are spiritually connected to the Golgulger Bilya (Avon River) through the story of the Wagyl (Rainbow Serpent). Prior to European settlement, a thriving population on Noongar people had inhabited the region for tens of thousands of years, living in harmony with the land.

With plenty of charming accommodation choices on offer, such as historic hotels or family run Bed and Breakfasts, revisit yesteryear where main streets are lined with bullnose verandas, cafes, bakeries and welcoming locals. Check into a historic hotel restored to its former glory, enjoy a hearty lunch in a country pub, visit a local museum or indulge in an afternoon Devonshire Tea at a quaint tearoom.

These friendly country towns showcase local produce such as jams, olives, chocolate and honey. Pile the scones high with jam and cream, relax and feel worlds away on this charming historical adventure!

The Avon Valley is the home of hot air ballooning and gliding, offering stunning views of the valley, the Avon River and endless fields of barley, wheat and canola, synonymous with the area. It's also host to an interesting range of festivals and events all year round; antique fairs and vintage car rallies, flower shows, farmers markets and the famous Avon Descent bring this historic region to life.

The Avon Valley is approximately 90 minutes drive from the Perth CBD and the easiest way to explore this wonderful region is by car. Alternatively visit www.transwa.wa.gov.au for all bus and train routes. Alternatively contact any of the Visitor Centres for assistance.


