Road Safety



A lack of sleep slows your reactions and decisions when driving, increasing the risk of a crash. It can also cause micro-sleep. Five seconds of this at 100km/h is like driving the length of a football field blindfolded. To arm yourself against fatigue, know the amount of sleep you need and get it regularly. On long journeys, take a break every two hours and swap drivers regularly.
