Looking for a great day out from the city?

Just an hour north of Perth, the Bindoon Mountain Bike Park is the ideal escape! No long drives, no entry fees, and no experience necessary. Spread across 100 hectares, the park offers sweeping views over the Chittering Valley. Trails are graded for all abilities, so whether you're a first-timer or a seasoned rider, you'll find something that suits. Beginners can ease into it on the gentler green trails, while more confident riders can push themselves on technical descents with rock gardens, chutes, and the fun-favourite dual slalom. Bikes are welcome too, so no one gets left behind. Parking is free and on site, and when the legs are done, Bindoon town is right there – grab a bite, browse the local shops, and soak up the relaxed country atmosphere before heading home.

The museum, which is housed in the Brockman Centre along the Great Northern Highway, is home to both the expanding collection of the Historical Society and the collections of Topsy and John Dickerson. The exhibits, which are separated between the large shed and the Old Road Board Building, showcase a variety of household items from the early 1900s to the present, together with agricultural and automobile machinery that demonstrates how much life in the area has evolved over the previous century.
